Afghans

- Should be knitted or crocheted with bright, cheerful colors (Our cabin colors are blue, green, yellow and red)
- Should be 35-40 inches wide by 45-50 inches long
- Design...be creative!!

Materials needed:

- 1/3 yard black and white check
- 1/4 yard black
- Small piece of white 5" x 3"
- Yarn: Blue, Green, Yellow, or Red
- Polyester Fiberfill
- Two 1" pieces of black Velcro

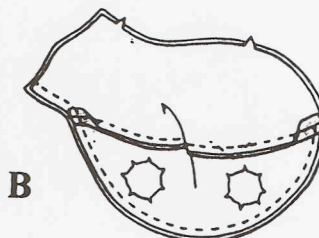
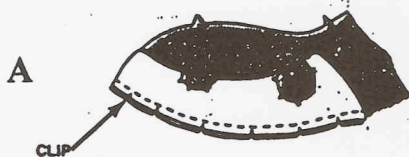
Assembly instructions

All seams are 1/4"

Stay stitch scant 1/4" around leg openings on Lower Body. Clip curves.

Stitch Upper Body to Lower Body matching notch. A

Stitch Lower Body sections together, continuing to stitch Upper Body from seam to neck edge. B



Leg and Foot

Sew Velcro to four of Foot 1 sections, keeping one edge of the Velcro 1/4" from straight edge. Be sure to make two right feet and two left feet

Sew one Velcro-ed Foot 1 to one un-velcro-ed Foot 1 section on the center seam. Clip Curves.

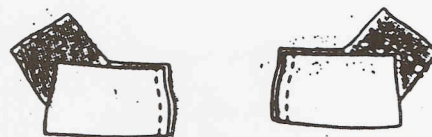
Stitch Foot 2 sections to un-velcro-ed Foot 1 section. C

For each Leg, stitch 2 leg sections along long straight edge.

Pin foot to leg, right sides together, matching side seams, circles, and center seam to circle on leg. Stitch. D

Stitch inner leg. Stitch Sole to foot, matching circles and square to center seam. E

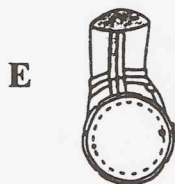
Attach legs to lower body matching squares and seams to circles. F



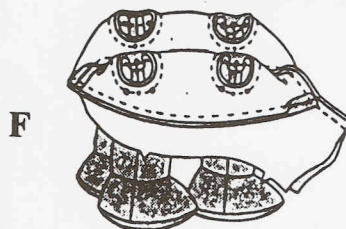

Tail

To make tail, cut a piece of cardboard 7" x 3"

Wrap yarn around length of cardboard for 1".

Slip yarn off cardboard and stitch ¼" from fold. Pin tail centering at tail position on one upper body, having fold of yarn even with raw edge. Baste in place.

Stitch upper body sections together, leaving free between notches.

Turn body right side out. Cut open loops on tail

Head

Stitch Muzzle 1 sections at center seam. Clip curves.

Stitch Muzzle 2 to Muzzle 1

Stay stitch a scant 1/4" from lower edge of Muzzle. Clip to stitching.

Pin Muzzle 3 to Muzzle 1&2 matching circles and square to center seam. Stitch.

Turn right side out.

Pin Head Front to Head Back, matching circles. Stitch between circles.

Stitch darts in Side. Press fold of dart away for center.

Pin sides to Head Front. Stitch from circles to lower edges.

Stitch short straight edge of sides together. **G**

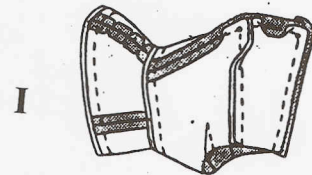
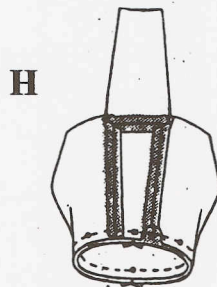
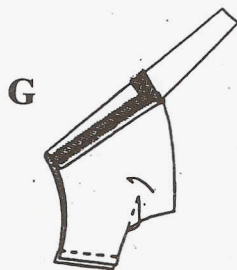
Pin Muzzle to Head Front and Side, matching center to square and circles to seams. Stitch. **H**

Stitch Head Back to Side from circle to lower edge. **I** Turn right side out.

Pin head to body, matching front seams and seam and darts to circles. Stitch

Turn Horse right side out.

Stuff head, legs and body firmly with fiber fill. Slip stitch opening edges together.



Mane

To make mane, cut strips of yarn 5 ½". Begin half way down center of back of upper body. Thread needle with yarn strips. Insert needle through center back seam, pulling to leave 2 ½" end. Take a back stitch, inserting and taking out in same point. Continue stitches 1/8" apart up to ear position.

Ears

Make dart in two Ear sections, making the inner ear.

Stitch one inner and outer ear together on curved areas. Clip curves.

Turn. Stuff firmly. Turn in raw edges in and slip stitch together.

Place ears on head and sew in place. **J**
